We have a variety of ways to get involved with **Rainforest Falls!** Whether you love being front-and-center with the kids or prefer working behind the scenes, there is a place for you.

**Crew Leaders (The Mentors)** *These roles are the "heart" of the program, providing consistency for the kids.*

- **Ages:** Preschool through 5th Grade.
- **The Role:** You are the primary connection for a specific small group of children. (5 kids) You'll guide them through their daily stations (Science, Games, Bible Adventure) and facilitate brief discussions or activities within your group. No preparation required.
- **Best for:** People who love building relationships and staying active with the kids throughout the day.
- **The Mission:** To be the friendly face and "home base" for a group of 5 children.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Lead your group safely from one station to the next.
  - Encourage participation during music and teaching times.
  - Facilitate simple "Circle Time" discussions using the provided curriculum.
  - Ensure all children in your group are checked out to an authorized adult at the end of the day.

### Crew Leader Assistants

- **The Mission:** To support the Crew Leader and provide an extra set of eyes and hands.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Sit with the children during activities to help them focus.
  - Help manage group transitions and keep the energy positive.

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**Station Specialists (The Experts): Sticky Scripture, Imagination Station, Bible Adventures** *These roles are the "engines" of the program, focused on specific activities.*

- **The Role:** Instead of staying with one group, you stay at one station and lead a specific activity for each group that rotates through.

### **Imagination Station (Science)**

- **The Mission:** To spark curiosity through hands-on discovery.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Set up supplies for the day's experiment (instructions provided!).
  - Demonstrate the experiment to each rotating group of children.
  - Help kids perform the task and connect it back to the daily theme.
  - Clean and reset the lab between rotations.

### **Games Leader**

- **The Mission:** To burn off energy and build community through play.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Explain the rules of the daily team-building game or outdoor activity.
  - Referee the games to ensure fairness and safety.
  - Manage equipment and ensure every child gets a turn to participate.

### **Bible Adventure**

- **The Mission:** Bring the Bible to life for groups of kids through interactive and engaging experiences, then help kids apply the word of God to their own lives.
- **Best for:** People who have a specific passion or "performer" energy and prefer a repetitive, high-impact schedule.

### **Snack Team**

- **The Mission:** To fuel our adventurers with "tasty treats."
- **Responsibilities:**
  - Prepare and portion out daily snacks according to the schedule.
  - **Strictly monitor** the allergy list for each crew/group to ensure safety.
  - Deliver snacks and set up the central snack station.

### **Special Needs Buddy**

- **The Mission:** Be a buddy to a preschool or elementary kid with special needs.
- **Responsibilities:**
  - You'll be part of a crew/group giving 1:1 care to ensure this child has a safe and fun week at KSA.

## The Afternoon Trek Guide (All-Day Program)

Option 1| All Day Volunteer: 7:30am-4:30pm

Option 2| PM Volunteer only: 12:00pm-4:30pm

- **The Mission:** To keep the adventure going for our 1st–5th grade explorers who have stayed for the extended day.
- **Responsibilities:** You'll transition students from the main morning program into an afternoon of "bonus" fun. This includes overseeing lunch, leading an extra "deep dive" craft or game, and ensuring a relaxed but engaging environment until afternoon pickup.  
**Perfect for:** High-energy volunteers who want to make a full day of it!
- Lunch provided for our All-Day program volunteers

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## Support Roles

## Setup/Teardown Team

- **The Mission:** Help the week run smoothly and ensure items are where they need to be.
- **Responsibilities:** Assist with various setup and teardown needs to help make the event run smoothly

## Fun in the Sun-Day Bouncy House Team

- **The Mission:** Assist with bouncy house activity monitoring so ensure safety of children
  - **Responsibilities:** Monitor number of children in bouncy house and ensure safety standards are being met. Ensure each child gets a chance to bounce.
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## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is the time commitment?

Volunteers are needed for the full duration of the program, **July 13–16**. We typically ask volunteers to arrive 30 minutes before the program starts for a morning huddle and prayer. Arrive by 7:30am for a grab and go breakfast to be fueled for the day.

Standard Volunteer Roles: 7:30am-12:30pm

Afternoon Volunteer Role: 12:00pm-4:30pm

All Day Volunteer Role: 7:30am-4:30pm

### **Do I need a background check?**

Yes. To ensure the safety of our children, all volunteers (18+) must complete a standard background check. All volunteers must attend a brief orientation session prior to July 13.

### **Can I request a specific age group?**

Absolutely! When you sign up, you can indicate your preference for the preschool program or **1st–5th grade**. We do our best to honor all requests!

### **What should I wear?**

Comfortable clothes you can move in and closed-toe shoes. We will provide you with a specific volunteer T-shirt to wear each day so families can easily identify our team.
